

Resolution No. 78-2019

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Declaring the intent to vacate a portion of East 176th Street.

Council Members J. Jones, Johnson and Brancatelli (by departmental request)

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause to vacate a portion of East 176th Street, as described; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council declares its intent to vacate a portion of the following described real property:

A portion of East 176th Street

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio and known as being a portion of East 176th Street in the Miles-Melbourne Subdivision of part of Original Warrensville Township Lot 83. Recorded in Volume 96 of Maps, Page 39 of Cuyahoga County Records, further described as follows:

Being all that portion of East 176th Street (40.00 feet wide) extending from the South line of Miles Avenue S.E. (86.00 feet wide) to that portion of East 176th Street vacated by City of Cleveland ordinance 1717-58, passed September 17, 1958 as shown on the recorded Vacation Plat of Parts of East 176th Street and Manoa Avenue S.E. in Volume 171 of Maps, Page 33 of Cuyahoga County Records.

Legal Description approved by Greg Esber, Section Chief, Plats, Surveys and House Numbering Section.

Section 2. That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
