DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES Division of Water Pollution Control Ordinance # 252-2019

This request for legislation is to amend Ordinance No. 422-18, passed May 14, 2018 for the public improvement of constructing the East 185th Street and Marcella Road Area Sewer Improvement Project by authorizing the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies to acquire, accept, and record for right-of-way purposes any real property and easement(s) necessary to make the improvements and to include the MOCAP, Division of Engineering and Construction fund codes for additional pavement restoration for the Division of Water Pollution Control, Department of Public Utilities.

Background/Purpose:

The East 185 Street and Marcella Road area has experienced basement and surface flooding during heavy rainstorms. NEORSD constructed a relief sewer two years ago on Lakeshore Boulevard that will help provide relief from flooding to the area around Lakeshore Blvd. This project will consist of the construction of a new relief sewer to help convey the flow from the area east of East 185 Street to the new sewer on Lakeshore Boulevard.

This amendment to the original ordinance is to provide authorization to purchase property easement(s) and include the MOCAP, Division of Engineering & Construction fund codes for additional pavement restoration. The Division of Water Pollution Control will be responsible to restore the pavement in the trench area. MOCAP, Division of Engineering & Construction will be responsible for pavement restoration planned for the entire street originally planned under a different project.

Scope of Work/Commodities/Services:

The project consists of the rehabilitation and replacement of sewers and the construction of a new relief main sewer on East 185 Street and Marcella Avenue in Ward 8.

Justification/Urgency:

Property easement(s) will be required for the project to give the right to encroach on the property for the purpose of constructing the relief sewer in the tunnel. The additional pavement restoration cost will be paid from the MOCAP, Division of Engineering and Construction funds.

Anticipated Costs and Funding Source:

The cost of the improvement and other expenditures authorized shall be paid from Fund 54, SF 001, Fund 21, SF 018 and any and all funds deemed necessary by the Director of Finance, and/or from the fund or subfund to which are credited the proceeds of current and future sewer bonds, if issued for this purpose or other funds from NEORSD's Stormwater Community Cost Share, and grants and/or loans from Ohio EPA or other sources.

Schedule or Term of Contract:

Contract has been awarded by BOC and is in signature process. Contract will be considered complete upon final acceptance by the Division of Water Pollution Control.
