

Ordinance No. 406-2019

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 2002 PS 2017-188 with National Urban Fellows to support the placement of a fellow in the class of 2020 within the Department of Public Utilities under the program.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 539-17, passed June 5, 2017, the Director of Public Utilities entered into Contract No. CT 2002 PS 2017-188 with National Urban Fellows to support the placement of a fellow in the class of 2018 and 2019 within the Department of Public Utilities under the program; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 539-17 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. CT 2002 PS 2017-188 with National Urban Fellows to support the placement of a fellow in the class of 2020 within the Department of Public Utilities under the program at a cost not to exceed \$70,000, payable from Fund No. 52 SF 001. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 539-17 to exercise this option. (RQS 2002, RL 2019-23)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
