WHEREAS, this Council objected to the transfer of location of a C2 and C2X Liquor Permit to 4380 State Road, Inc., DBA Save More Mart, 4380 State Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44109, Permit No. 28767030005 by Resolution No. 1128-18 adopted by the Council on September 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above transfer and consents to said transfer; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

**Section 1.** That objection to the transfer of location of a C2 and C2X Liquor Permit to 4380 State Road, Inc., DBA Save More Mart, 4380 State Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44109, Permit No. 28767030005, be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 1128-18, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate transfer thereof.

**Section 2.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
