WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above transfer and consents to said transfer; and

<u>Section 1.</u> That objection to the transfer of location of a D2, D2X and D3 Liquor Permit to R & T 17001 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44112, Permit No. 7569712, be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 430-18, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate transfer thereof.
