Sale of Temporary Easements in City-Owned Land to ODOT for the Detroit-Superior Bridge Rehab Project

Legislative Purpose: Authorizing the Director of Public Works to convey

temporary easement interests in City owned

property to the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) needed for the Detroit-Superior Bridge

Rehab Project.

Project Summary: The City received a request for temporary

easements from ODOT for portions of two City owned parcels as part of its planned improvement of the Detroit-Superior Bridge. The properties consist of parts of the current Canal Basin Parking Lot (PPN 101-15-021) and a portion of Settler's Landing (PPN

101-15-009) adjacent to Robert Lockwood Jr. Dr. by

RTA's Waterfront Line station.

The project consists of replacement of the upper deck wearing surface, concrete patching or replacement lower substructure, substructure, station and tunnel components, installation of fiber-reinforced polymer wraps over public area, construction of vandal protection walls, modifications to the Center Street Swing Bridge operator's car shelter, restoration of navigation lighting, and drainage repair.

The temporary easements are needed for protection under the bridge from damage while the work is being done. The contractor will also be evaluating the condition of the bridge within both temporary easement areas. The contractor will not be permitted to store material or equipment within the temporary easement area and will restore any damage caused by the construction activities.
