NORTHEAST OHIO MUNI FOOTBALL LEAGUE

DIVISION: Recreation

ORDINANCE NO: 389-2019

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Works to enter into a contract with Northeast Ohio Muni Football League, aka Cleveland Municipal Football Association dba Cleveland Muny Football League to conduct a citywide youth football program.

CONTRACT TERMS: One year contract: May 1, 2019 – December 31, 2019

ESTIMATED AMOUNT: \$80,084 - The Northeast Ohio Muni Football League uses this amount to supplement costs as follows:

PREVIOUS CONTRACT: Contract No. CT-7004-PS-2018-116 - \$80,098

PROGRAM BACKGROUND: Northeast Ohio Muni Football League has been in existence for over 90 years. More than 93,000 youth from the ages of 6-14 have participated in the program.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

There were a total of 20 organizations in 2018 totaling 60 football teams and 39 cheerleader squads. The team age divisions are as follows:
