EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to purchase by one or more contracts of one aircraft rescue and firefighting vehicle, for the Division of Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, Department of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is requesting new legislation authorizing the purchase of one ARFF vehicle for the Aircraft Rescue Firefighting section.

Scope of Work:

The Airport Rescue and Firefighting ("ARFF") would like to replace one 2003 Oshkosh Stryker 1500 gallon ARFF vehicle (ARFF 14) with a new generation 1500 gallon ARFF vehicle.

Justification/Urgency:

The purchase of this vehicle will facilitate the emergency response capabilities and reliability of the Cleveland Airport System ARFF section to serve all of the airport employees, tenants, and air travelers with the highest quality of Aircraft Rescue Firefighting services. This will enable the airport to continue to maintain the required 24 hour a day protection of firefighting capabilities that support safe aircraft operations.

Cleveland Hopkins International Airport currently has three operational ARFF vehicles, two being newer Rosenbauer 3000 gallons with High Reach Extendable Turret (HRET), both listed in excellent condition. The 2003 Oshkosh Stryker 1500 being replaced is considered fair condition, because of several issues with the roof turret and bumper turret failing and wandering. Oshkosh has been consulted on this issue and the only possible fix of the problem would be to completely rebuild the turret electrical system, the turret and switching the turret to a pneumatic control. This would render this vehicle out of service for a lengthy timeframe.
