EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority by one or more requirement contracts of FAA-approved deicing chemicals, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control, for a period of two years, with two one-year options to renew, the first shall require additional legislative authority.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is required to maintain all taxiways and runways free and clear of accumulations of snow and ice to ensure the safe operations of aircraft during the winter season.

Scope of Work:

To provide deicing agents for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control, on an as needed basis, as determined by the Department of Port Control in its sole discretion.

Justification/Urgency:

The Department of Port Control must ensure the safe operation of aircraft on the runways and taxiways the during the winter season. In order to maintain safe operating conditions the Department must periodically spread deicing chemicals on the runways and taxiways in order to prevent accumulations of ice and snow.

The current contract for deicing chemical will expire February 2nd, 2020 (NaChurs Alpine Solutions).

Anticipated cost:

The anticipated cost for the deicing chemicals is approximately \$5,000,000.00 for two years.

Schedule or Term of Contract:

The Department of Port Control is requesting a term of two-years with (2) one-year options to renew, the first shall require additional legislative authority.
