AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Health to enter into one or more agreements with the Ohio Department of Health to reimburse the City of Cleveland for monitoring, collecting, and analyzing radiation levels in the vicinity of the Burke Lakefront Airport, for a period of two years.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the

usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Public Health is authorized to enter into one or

more agreements with the Ohio Department of Health to reimburse the City of

Cleveland for monitoring, collecting, and analyzing radiation levels in the vicinity of the

Burke Lakefront Airport, for a period of two years, and the funds are appropriated for

this purpose. The Director of Public Health is authorized to file all papers and execute

all documents necessary to receive the funds under this ordinance.

Section 2. That funds received under this ordinance shall be deposited into

Fund 10 SF 812, and shall be used for operation of the Division of Air Quality.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
