## Food Shop Licenses and Fees Executive Summary

## Background/Purpose:

This legislation amends Section 241.05, of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 1333-18, passed November 26, 2018, relating to Food Shop Licenses and Fees and Categories and Fees.

The Ohio Department of Health has instructed the Cleveland Department of Public Health to amend Section 241.05 (h) and (m).

The following are the required amendments.

1. Amend section 241.05 (h) - Food Shop Licenses and Fees as follows: Delete "Plan Review Re-inspection Fee" and each fee listed below the two headings labeled Commercial = "\$100.00" & Non-Commercial= "\$100.00".

**Justification** - The Ohio Department of Health determined this type of fee is not permissible under the current Ohio Food Safety Code regulations.

- 2. Amend section 241.05 (m) Food Shop Licenses and Fees as follows: Delete the entire section "m" that reads:
- "(m) For purposes of this section, whenever an operation or establishment has applied for a license and scheduled an inspection, for which passage is required prior to license approval, and it cannot obtain the license because it does not meet all applicable requirements to obtain the license, it must pay an additional inspection fee, a Plan Review Reinspection Fee, for that additional inspection."

**Justification** - The Ohio Department of Health determined this type of fee is not permissible under the current Ohio Food Safety Code regulations.
