**East 116<sup>th</sup>/Harvard Signal, PID 106732**

**Ordinance:**                   **630-2019**

**Purpose:**                   This Department requests legislation to grant consent to ODOT to upgrade the signal at the south leg of East 116<sup>th</sup> Street and Harvard Avenue intersection and to authorize the Director of Capital Projects to enter into one or more agreements with ODOT to make the improvement.

**Description:**           ODOT will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost and contribute 100% of the eligible costs. The project will upgrade the traffic signal at the south leg of East 116<sup>th</sup> Street and Harvard Avenue intersection and interconnect it with the preemption at the Cleveland Commercial Railroad crossing across East 116<sup>th</sup> Street just north of the intersection at Harvard Avenue. This is a safety upgrade stopping traffic on Harvard when the rail gates are triggered by an approaching train to East 116<sup>th</sup>. The project is sponsored by the Ohio Rail Development Commission.
