## East 116<sup>th</sup>/Harvard Signal, PID 106732

**Ordinance: 630-2019** 

**Purpose:** This Department requests legislation to grant consent to

ODOT to upgrade the signal at the south leg of East 116<sup>th</sup> Street and Harvard Avenue intersection and to authorize the

Director of Capital Projects to enter into one or more agreements with ODOT to make the improvement.

**Description:** ODOT will arrange for the preparation of construction plans

and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost and contribute 100% of the eligible costs. The project will upgrade the traffic signal at the south leg of East 116<sup>th</sup> Street and Harvard Avenue intersection and interconnect it with the preemption at the Cleveland Commercial Railroad

crossing across East 116<sup>th</sup> Street just north of the

intersection at Harvard Avenue. This is a safety upgrade stopping traffic on Harvard when the rail gates are triggered

by an approaching train to East 116th. The project is sponsored by the Ohio Rail Development Commission.

**Cost Estimate:** \$165,000

**Funding Source:** 100% – Ohio Department of Transportation

**Schedule:** Design: Jan. 2019 – Oct. 2019

Construction: March 2020 – August 2020

**Ward:** 2, Councilmember Bishop
