Purpose:	This Department requests legislation to grant consent to the County to apply for and accept an allocation of County Motor Vehicle License Tax Funds and authorizing the Director of Mayor's Office of Capital Projects to enter into one or more contracts by requirements for the construction, design, and any relative agreements in making of the improvement; from any and all funds as authorized by the Director of Finance necessary to fund the improvement.
Description:	The City will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost and County will contribute up to a maximum of \$250,000 of the eligible costs. The improvements include asphalt milling, pavement base repair, asphalt resurfacing and installation of ADA compliant ramps from Broadway Avenue to Central Furnace Drive, approximately 3,500 feet. This project was selected based on its poor pavement condition rating to be part of the County Program. The program's goal is to improve pavement condition on the County Road system.
