Purpose:	This Department requests legislation to grant consent and cause payment to the County to construct the improvement on East 116 th Street from Miles Avenue to Union Avenue and to enter into one or more agreements with the County to make the improvement.		
Description:	The County will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost. Public Works Commission Issue 1 grant was received for 50% of the construction cost. County will contribute 100% of the design and 25% of the construction. City will contribute 25% of construction. The improvements include asphalt milling, pavement base repair, asphalt resurfacing and installation of ADA compliant ramps from Miles Ave. to Union Ave., approximately 1.25 miles. This project includes a single lane roundabout at intersection of Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., E 116 th St. and Farringdon Road. The roundabout was programmed by County and City Traffic Engineering Section to improve vehicular and pedestrian safety at this location.
