

# East 116<sup>th</sup> St. Resurfacing, County ID No. 1170

**Purpose:** This Department requests legislation to grant consent and cause payment to the County to construct the improvement on East 116<sup>th</sup> Street from Miles Avenue to Union Avenue and to enter into one or more agreements with the County to make the improvement.

**Description:** The County will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost. Public Works Commission Issue 1 grant was received for 50% of the construction cost. County will contribute 100% of the design and 25% of the construction. City will contribute 25% of construction. The improvements include asphalt milling, pavement base repair, asphalt resurfacing and installation of ADA compliant ramps from Miles Ave. to Union Ave., approximately 1.25 miles. This project includes a single lane roundabout at intersection of Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., E 116<sup>th</sup> St. and Farrington Road. The roundabout was programmed by County and City Traffic Engineering Section to improve vehicular and pedestrian safety at this location.
