Certified Local Government Grant to Establish the Midtown Historic District on the National Register of Historic Places

Ordinance No.:	710-2019
Purpose:	Authorizing the Director of City Planning to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio History Connection State Historic Preservation Office / Ohio Development Services Agency to prepare a National Register of Historic Places Nomination to recognize and preserve the Midtown Historic District and to promote economic development through Historic Tax Credits; and authorizing the director to enter into one or more contracts for professional consultants to implement this ordinance.
Description:	The grant will facilitate establishment of the Midtown Historic District on the National Register of Historic Places.
Cost Estimate:	\$30,000 (\$0 Local Match)
Funding Source:	Certified Local Government Grant, Ohio History Connection and Ohio Development Services Agency
Timeline:	July, 2019-September, 2020
Wards:	5 and 7 (Cleveland and B. Jones)
