An emergency resolution declaring the intent to vacate a portion of the Clark Avenue Extension S.W.

**WHEREAS**, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause to vacate a portion of the Clark Avenue Extension S.W., as described; and

**WHEREAS**, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

**Section 1.** That this Council declares its intent to vacate a portion of the following described real property:

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio and known as being part of original Brooklyn Township Lots 86 and 87, further described as follows:

Being all that portion of the Clark Avenue Extension S.W. (63.00 feet wide) as shown on the Clark Street Extension Dedication Plat in Volume 12 of Maps, Page 2 & 3 of Cuyahoga County Records, extending from the West right of way of West 5<sup>th</sup> Street (60.00 feet wide, now vacated) as shown on the Vacation Plat of part of North Clark Ave. S.W. 50', W. 3<sup>rd</sup> St.-50' & W. 5<sup>th</sup> St.-60' in Volume 227 of Maps, Page 13 of Cuyahoga County Records, easterly to the Cuyahoga River.

Legal Description approved by Greg Esber, Section Chief, Plats, Surveys and House Numbering Section.

**Section 2.** That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
