AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to accept a gift of a trailer, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations ("OBCI") has indicated a

desire to make a gift of a trailer to assist the Division of Police Bomb Squad in their

efforts to respond to clandestine drug lab operations; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the

usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to accept on behalf

of the Division of Police a trailer from OBCI, valued at \$18,000, to assist the Cleveland

Bomb Squad in their efforts to respond to clandestine drug lab operations.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
