

Ordinance No. 1474-18**Council Members:** Johnson and Kelley

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into one or more contracts with Link2Park, Inc. dba Linkology for professional services necessary to provide software, hardware, training, technical support, and maintenance, for the Parking Access and Revenue Control System for Willard Parking Garage, Gateway Parking Garage and the West Side Market parking lots, for the Division of Parking Facilities, Department of Public Works, for a period of three years, with one two-year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Link2Park, Inc. dba Linkology for professional services necessary to provide software, hardware, training, technical support maintenance, including but not limited to, inspections, cleaning, lubricating, equipment adjustment, and parts and labor required for repair or replacement, and on-call maintenance, including equipment, parts, services, and labor necessary to keep the Parking Access and Revenue Control System for Willard Parking Garage, Gateway Parking Garage and the West Side Market parking lots functional and operational, on the basis of their proposal dated July 18, 2018, for the Division of Parking Facilities, Department of Public Works, for a period of three years, with one two-year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund No. 65 SF 001, Request No. RQS 7008, RLA 2018-55.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
