- SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 1241-2019 Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to Apply for and Accept a grant from the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for the FY19 Overdose to Action Plan grant

Ordinance No. 1241-2019 would authorize the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the Cuyahoga County Board of Health for the FY19 Overdose to Action Plan. If approved by Council, the legislation will provide funding for personnel for the Division of Police.

Purpose of Grant:

The goal of the Overdose to Action Plan Grant is to provide funding to improve the system of care in abating the deadly effects of the opioid epidemic. The Cleveland Division of Police partnered with the Cuyahoga County Board of Health in applying for a federal grant. We will be a subrecipient of the County. Cleveland's portion of the funds will pay for the salary of an intelligence analyst who will assist in analyzing and disseminating overdose data throughout the county. They will develop geospatial maps, layering data from law enforcement agencies and other partners.
