Ordinance No. 247-2019

An emergency ordinance to supplement Ordinance No. 1261-18, passed October 29, 2018, by adding new Section 2 relating to professional services to provide professional services for pre-employment background and criminal checks for the Department of Human Resources; and to renumber existing Sections 2 and 3 to new Sections 3 and 4.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1261-18, passed October 29, 2018, is supplemented by adding new Section 2 to read as follows:

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the purchases authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Human Resources may sign all documents that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through that cooperative process.

Section 2. That existing Sections 2 and 3 of Ordinance No. 1261-18, passed October 29, 2018, are renumbered to new "Section 3" and "Section 4".

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
