Ordinance No. 328-2019

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation to maintain, repair, and plow the Jennings Freeway in exchange for road salt, for a period of two years, with three one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation, for the State to maintain, repair, and plow the Jennings Freeway in exchange for road salt, for a period of two years, with three one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works. (RQS 7016, RLA 2019-19)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
