

**Ordinance No. 388-2019**

**Council Members:** Keane, Kelley and Mayor Jackson

**An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more contracts with Youth Opportunities Unlimited for the administration, implementation, and management of the Cleveland Summer Youth Employment Program and authorizing one or more contracts with public agencies or communities to implement the Summer Youth Employment Program, for a period of one year, with a one-year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Utilities.**

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:**

**Section 1.** That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Youth Opportunities Unlimited for the administration, implementation, and management of the Cleveland Summer Youth Employment Program, which include various projects for a period of one year, with a one-year option to renew exercisable by the Director of Public Utilities.

**Section 2.** That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with public agencies or communities to implement elements of the Summer Youth Employment Program for a period of one year, with one option to renew for an additional one-year period, exercisable by the Director of Public Utilities.

**Section 3.** That the cost of the contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund Nos. 52 SF 001 and 54 SF 001, Request No. RQS 2002, RL 2019-12.

**Section 4.** That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
