

**Ordinance No. 480-2019**

**An emergency ordinance authorizing the Directors of Public Works and Finance to enter into one or more contractual agreements with the Cleveland Metropolitan School District to conduct educational, recreational and extracurricular programming through the use of Ward 14 Casino Revenue Funds.**

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:**

**Section 1.** That the Directors of Public Works and Finance are to enter into one or more contractual agreements effective April 29, 2019, with the Cleveland Metropolitan School District to conduct educational, recreational and extracurricular programming for the public purpose of providing after-school educational and recreational activities through the use of Ward 14 Casino Revenue Funds.

**Section 2.** That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$3,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

**Section 3.** That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract, and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as he deems necessary to protect the City's interest.

**Section 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
