East 93rd - East 105th Multi-Modal

Ordinance No. 700-2019

Purpose: This Department requests legislation to grant consent to the

ODOT to construct the improvement on East -93rd – East 105th, PID 108245; to enter into one or more Professional Service contracts; to enter into agreements with private utilities and to accept funds; to apply for and accept federal funds; to enter into agreements and to accept funds from Railroads, NEORSD and GCRTA, to enter into a local public agency federal agreement with ODOT; to authorize the Division of Purchasing and Supplies to acquire, accept, and record all land necessary in making of the public improvement, including but not limited to gift, fee simple acquisitions, temporary easements, permanent easements, and work agreements; to add any and all funds as authorized by

Director of Finance.

Description: The Thrive 105/93 Concept Plan, dated September 2017, was

developed as part of Mayor Jackson's Neighborhood Transformation Initiative. It sets a new course for the East 93rd/Woodhill/East 105th Corridor in the City of Cleveland by identifying opportunities for investment and connecting those opportunities through quality

and efficient multi-modal transportation options.

Step 1. includes professional services for Preliminary and Environmental Engineering and establishing the Scope of Work for Step 2. Step 2 includes Final Engineering and Right of Way

Acquisition to implement the improvements.

This project is City sponsored and ODOT administered, utilizing federal funding for design. Construction financing will be determined once the preliminary engineering and cost estimates

have been completed.

Funding Source: \$3,563,000 - Federal (Design)

\$1,000,000 - Road and Bridge Bonds \$1,200,000 - Federal (Construction)

Construction Estimate: \$20,000,000
