Council Member(s) Johnson and Kelley (by departmental request) <u>AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE</u> Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with Jack Doheny Companies, Inc. to purchase one used 2016 Pelican Sweeper, including associated appurtenances, for the Division of Motor Vehicle Maintenance, Department of Public Works.

WHEREAS, while leasing the 2016 Pelican Sweeper from Jack Doheny

Companies, Inc. the sweeper was involved in an accident by one of our City drivers; and

WHEREAS, under the lease, the cost of repairs is greater than the purchase; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council determines that the within commodities are noncompetitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Jack Doheny Companies, Inc. Therefore the Director of Public Works is authorized to make one or more written contracts with Jack Doheny Companies, Inc. for the purchase of a 2016 Pelican Sweeper, including associated appurtenances, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Motor Vehicle Maintenance, Department of Public Works.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the purchases authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Public Works may sign all documents that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through that cooperative process.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the contract or contracts authorized shall not exceed \$152,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-0117-6950. (RQS 7015, RL 2019-127)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
