Cleveland Memorial Gardens – Detention Pond

Ordinance No.	1442-2019	
Purpose:	This Department requests legislation to authorize the Director of Mayor's Office of Capital Projects or Director of Public Works; to accept grants or gifts from any public or private entity; to enter into agreements as are necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this ordinance.	
Description:	PNC Building at 23000 Millcreek, Highland Hills is receiving a new tenant which requires a parking lot expansion. Additional storm water detention capacity is required within the existing detention pond located within Cleveland Memorial Gardens. The existing detention pond was constructed with the original shared Cleveland/Highland Hills business park. The developer will reshape and regrade the detention pond and gift the improvement to the City. Division of Engineering and Construction has reviewed and approved the improvement plan.
