# Ordinance No. 178 -2020

### Council Member Kelley (by departmental request)

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE** To make appropriations and provide current expenses for the daily operation of all municipal departments of the City of Cleveland for the fiscal year from January 1, 2020 until December 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the daily operation of a municipal department; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1</u>. That to provide for the current expenses for the City of Cleveland for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, the following sums be and they are hereby appropriated via:

The sum of Six Hundred Seventy Million, Six Hundred Fifty Thousand, Seven Hundred Forty Eight Dollars (\$670,650,748) from the General Fund;

The sum of One Hundred Thirteen Million, Two Hundred Fifty Two Thousand, Six Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$113,252,675) from the Special Revenue Funds;

The sum of Seventy Nine Million, Two Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$79,278,350) from the Debt Service Fund;

The sum of One Hundred Fifty One Million, Six Hundred Eighty Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty Six Dollars (\$151,686,986) from the Internal Service Funds;

The sum of Eight Hundred Ten Million, Eight Hundred Five Thousand, Ninety Six Dollars (\$810,805,096) from the Enterprise Funds;

The sum of Twelve Million, Five Hundred Ninety Four Thousand, Forty Three Dollars (\$12,594,043) from the Trust and Agency Funds;

<u>Section 2</u>. That the appropriations herein made are based upon the detail of expenditures set forth in the Mayor's Estimate, but are appropriated to the several departments, offices, and purposes in the aggregate for I. - Personnel and Related Expenses; and II. - Other Expenses and are not severally and individually appropriated in said detail. Any unencumbered balance in an

appropriation fund at the close of the year 2019 is hereby appropriated to such fund for the payment of unpaid obligations lawfully incurred in 2020 or prior years. The Mayor's Estimate, as modified by the schedule published pursuant to Section 39 of the Charter shall within the sums appropriated in Section 1 hereof, constitute the expenditure budget for the year 2020 and shall be subject to the control of the Mayor, provided, however, that no transfer from I. - Personnel and Related Expenses, or II. – Other Expenses within any department or office, or from one department or office to another shall be made except as provided in Section 41 of the Charter.

Section 3. That the Commissioner of Accounts is hereby authorized to draw warrants upon the City Treasury for the amount appropriated in this ordinance, whenever claims are presented properly approved by the head of the department or by the chief of a commission for which indebtedness was incurred.

<u>Section 4</u>. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
