Morris Avenue Encroachment

Ordinance Number: 27-2020

Description: Authorizing the Director of Capital Projects to issue a permit to Leonard J. Edwards to encroach into the public right-of-way of Morris Avenue by installing, using, and maintaining a fence and landscaping.

Purpose: This is a request from the City of Cleveland Engineering & Construction Design Section as part of the Safe Routes to School project (SRTS FY2012) to correct an existing unpermitted fence encroachment. Morris Court is along the route to Daniel E. Morgan K-8 School, and the encroachment occurs along a block where the public right-of-way is wider than in the other blocks. The encroachment does not conflict with the school pedestrian route or with the proposed work. The project will improve crosswalks and sidewalks along Morris Court with federal funding, and the City will need to certify that the existing right of way is cleared and available to the contractor for construction of the project. This includes certifying that all necessary encroachments are properly listed so that right of way clearance work can be undertaken and completed as required for proper coordination with the construction schedule.

A consent form acknowledging approval of this request has been received from the Council Member.
