## **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the Cleveland Firefighters Local 93; and to amend Sections 58 and 59 of Ordinance No. 323-15, passed March 30, 2015, as amended, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with the Cleveland Firefighters Local 93, under the terms contained in File No. **File No. 345-2020-A**, for the period from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2022, and which provides, among other things, for an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:
