If passed by Council, Ordinance No. 253-2020 would authorize a grant from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services for the FY18 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Grant. This grant will provide funding for the operation of the Police Homicide Review Commission.

The purpose of the Police Homicide Review Commission is to solve homicides in a more efficient and effective manner; to gain a better understanding of homicides through strategic problem-solving analysis; to develop innovative and effective responses and prevention strategies that result in a reduction of homicides; and to help better focus available prevention and intervention resources.

This grant also includes contracts with Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office to implement the grant.
