AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 742-2019 passed June 3, 2019 as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Economic Development to enter into agreement with Lexington Bell Community Center for the acquisition and renovation of the Superior Beverage Building through the use of Ward 7 Casino Revenue Funds and Neighborhood Capital Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 742-2019 passed June 3, 2019 are hereby amended to read as follows:

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of Economic Development to enter into agreement with Lexington Bell Community Center for the acquisition and renovation of the Superior Beverage Building through the use of Ward 7 Casino Revenue Funds, <u>Neighborhood Equity Funds</u> and Neighborhood Capital Funds.

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Economic Development is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with Lexington Bell Community Center for the acquisition and renovation of the Superior beverage Building located at 6203 Superior Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio for the public purpose of promoting economic development and new job creation through the use of Ward 7 Casino Revenue Funds, Neighborhood Equity Funds and Neighborhood Capital Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$225,000 \$200,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 177, Fund No. 10 SF 166 and Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 742-2019 passed June 3, 2019 are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
