## CUY 422-04.34, PID 110426 Kinsman Road/East 93<sup>rd</sup> Street Safety Improvements

Ordinance No.	355-2020	
Purpose:	This Department requests legislation to grant consent to ODOT to construct Safety Improvements at the intersection of Kinsman Road (U.S. Route 422) and East 93rd Street, PID 110426, in the City of Cleveland and to authorize the Director of Capital Projects to enter into one or more agreements with ODOT to make the improvement.	
Description:	ODOT will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost and contribute 100% of the eligible costs. The improvements include adding left turn lanes to all four legs of the intersection by widening the pavement on Kinsman Road. The work also includes reconfiguring the Ramona Boulevard intersection, installing new curb ramps, walks, signage and pavement markings, and lighting and signal improvements. Right of Way acquisition will be required to accommodate the pavement widening. These enhancements are part of ODOT's initiative to improve safety at intersections on the Highway Safety Priority List. Kinsman/East 93 <sup>rd</sup> is ranked #3 on the state-wide 2018 Urban Intersection Priority List.
