AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS 2018-64 with Ernst & Young LLP to manage and administer the Oracle Customer Care and Billing System.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 414-17, passed May 8, 2017, the Director of Public Utilities entered into Contract No. PS 2018-64 with Ernst & Young LLP ("Ernst & Young") to manage and administer the Oracle Customer Care and Billing System; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 414-17 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS 2018-64 with Ernst & Young to manage and administer the Oracle Customer Care and Billing System at a cost not to exceed \$1,581,534. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 414-17 to exercise this option. (RQS 2002, RL 2020-67)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
