# **Ordinance No. 909-2020**

FOR PASSAGE November 18, 2020

#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 10; and to amend Section 11 of Ordinance No. 323-15, passed March 30, 2015, as amended, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 10, under the terms contained in **File No. 909-2020-A**, for the period from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2022, and which provides, among other things, for an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:

Section 2. That Section 11 of Ordinance No. 323-15, passed March 30, 2015, as amended by Ordinance No. 491-15, passed May 4, 2015, Ordinance No. 707-16, passed July 13, 2016, and Ordinance No. 263-19, passed March 4, 2019, is amended to read as follows:

<u>Section 11</u>. <u>International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 10</u>. That salaries and compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
