

Ordinance No. 952-2020

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into a grant agreement with the Near West Side Multi-Service Corporation dba May Dugan Center, to make repairs to the City-owned facility located at 4115 Bridge Avenue.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Community Development is authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the Near West Side Multi-Service Corporation to finance repairs to the City-owned facility located at 4115 Bridge Avenue.

Section 2. That the agreement and other appropriate documents needed to complete the transactions authorized by this legislation shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the cost of the grant shall not exceed an amount of \$425,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 14 SF 040 (RQS 8006, RL 2020-117) and prior year balances.

Section 4 That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
