Ord. No. 937-2020

By Council Members Kazy and Kelley (by departmental request)

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more agreements with Cuyahoga County to design, reconstruct, and attach a new trunk main to the new Hilliard Road bridge over the Rocky River as part of the County's bridge reconstruction project; and to provide a pre-payment or reimburse the County for the City's share of the improvement.

Estimated Cost: \$1,300,000

Ord. No. 955-2020

Determining the method of making the public improvement of rehabilitating automated control systems at Division of Water treatment plants, secondary facilities, and in the distribution system; and authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more public improvement contracts for the making of the improvement.

Estimated Cost: \$3,000,000

Authorizing the purchase by one or more requirement contracts of landscape materials, supplies, and services, including labor and materials, needed to maintain, test, install, replace, improve, restore, and refurbish landscaping and tree lawns located at City-owned or leased Public Utility facilities and City right-of-ways, for the Divisions of Water, Water Pollution Control, and Cleveland Public Power, and the Office of Radio Communications, Department of Public Utilities, for a period of two years.

Authorizing the purchase by one or more requirement contracts of labor and materials necessary to repair and maintain the decorative and special lighting for City bridges and the Wyland Whale Mural Park on North Marginal Road, including materials, equipment, appurtenances, services, and insurance, for the Division of Cleveland Public Power, Department of Public Utilities, for a period of two years with two one-year options to renew, the first of which requires additional legislative authority.

Ord. No. 14-2021

By Council Members Kazy and Kelley (by departmental request)

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to make alterations and modifications in Contract No. PI 2019-4 with Terrace Construction Company, Inc. for constructing the East 85th Street and Chester Parkway Area Sewer Project; and authorizing the Director to apply for and accept funding from the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District for Community Cost Share Program funding to implement this ordinance.

Estimated Cost: \$1,293,065
