- **SUBJECT:** Ordinance No. 941-2020 authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services for the FY 20 State Byrne Memorial Grant for the operation of the Northern Ohio Law Enforcement Task Force (NOLETF); and authorizing the Director to enter into agreements with various municipalities, Cuyahoga County, and police agencies needed to implement the grant

Ordinance No. 941-2020, if passed by Council, would authorize the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a \$130,984 grant from the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services for the FY20 State Byrne Memorial Grant. This legislation will provide funding for the operation of the Northern Ohio Law Enforcement Task Force (NOLETF).

Purpose of Grant:

The goal of the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services Justice Assistance Grant is to provide funding to law enforcement agencies for operating multi-agency task forces. The City of Cleveland will be reimbursed for costs associated with operating the Division of Police's Northern Ohio Law Enforcement Task Force (NOLETF). The NOLETF is a multi-agency drug task force that brings together state, federal and local agents and investigators to ensure the most sophisticated investigation and prosecution resources are directed against organized drug trafficking groups.
