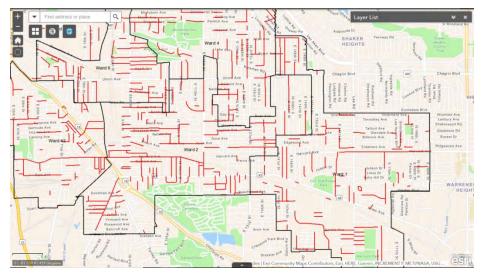


# **Resurfacing Program**

- Linear miles constructed will total in excess of 107.47



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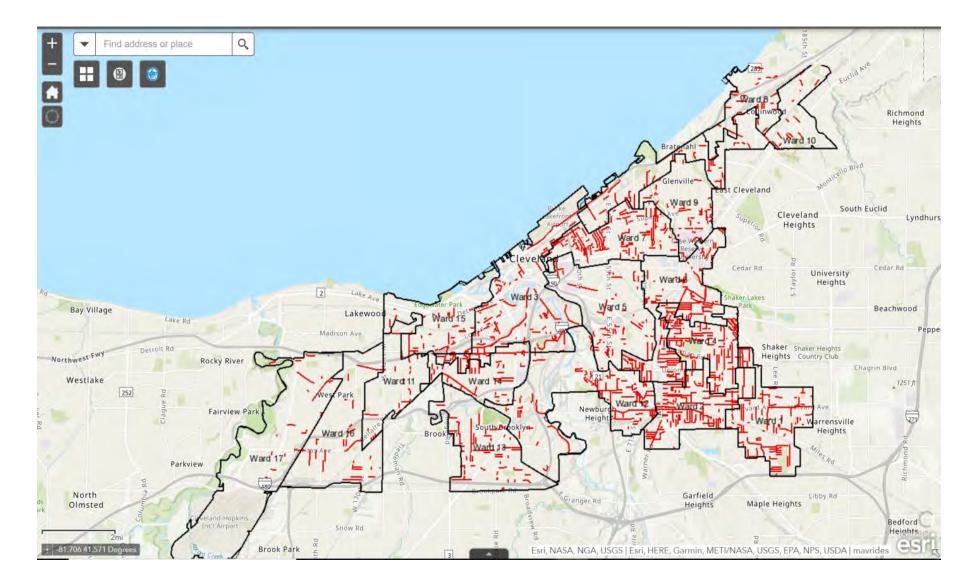

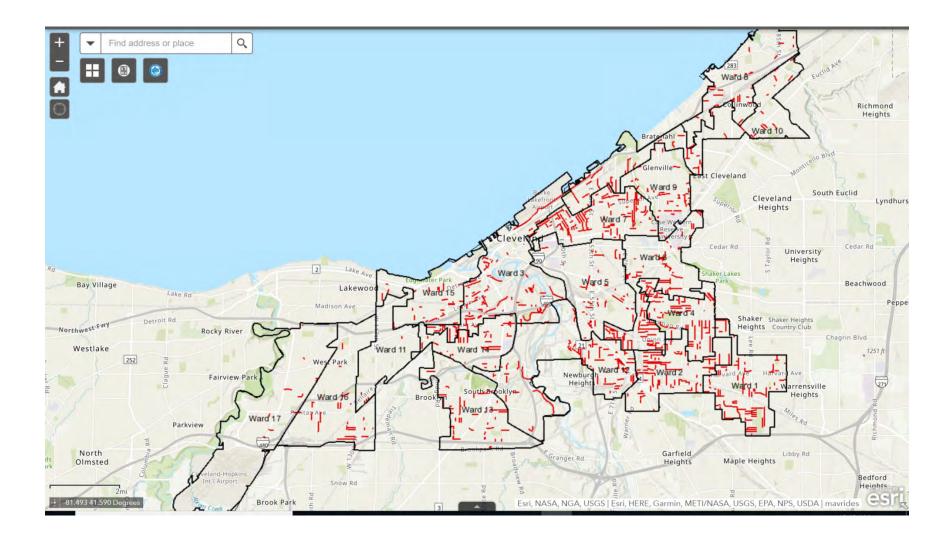

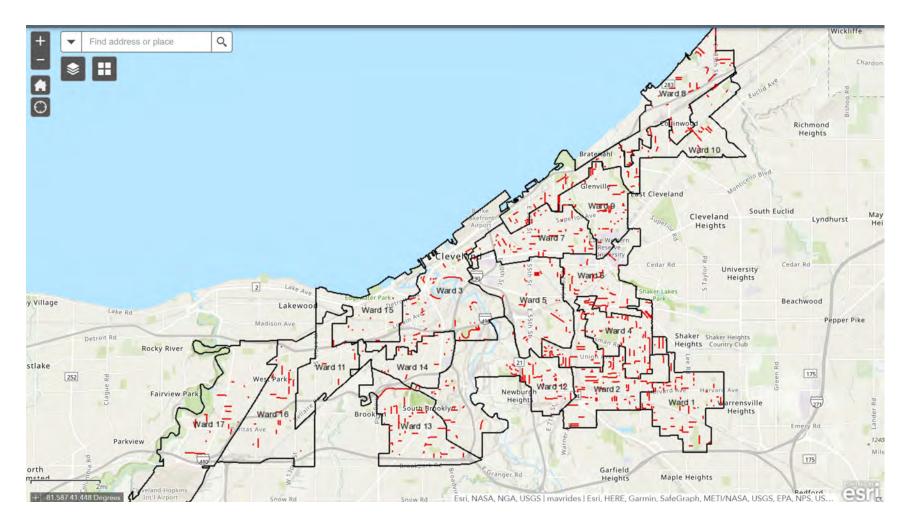

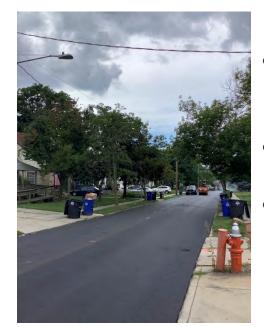
