AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 986-2020, passed December 9, 2020, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into an agreement with Lexington Bell Community Center for the Code Enforcement Program through the use of Ward 7 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 986-2020, passed December 9, 2020, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter into agreement effective November 1, 2020, with Lexington Bell Community Center for the Code Enforcement Program for the public purpose of eliminating slum and blight in the City of Cleveland through the use of Ward 7 Casino Revenue Funds.

<u>Section 2.</u> That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 986-2020, passed December 9, 2020, is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
