#### AN ORDINANCE

To amend Sections 533.15, 535.04, 535.05 and 535.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by various ordinances relating to fees and charges for water service; and to repeal Section 535.37, as amended by Ordinance No. 537-01, passed May 13, 2002, relating to using water without permission and penalty.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

#### Section 533.15 Tampering with Meters; Fee

If the Division of Water finds that a meter seal has been broken, or that there is good evidence that a meter has been tampered with, the water shall be shut off and not turned on again until (1) the payment set forth under Section 535.06 of the Codified Ordinances and (2) the payment of a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) fee has been made to the Division. The consumer or owner of the premises shall also pay for twice the estimated quantity of water which has not been registered because of tampering with the meter.

- (a) No person shall tamper, or cause or knowingly permit the tampering of, any component of a Division of Water system ("System"), perform inappropriate activities related to the water system including but not limited to:
  - (1) Breaking the seal on a water meter or bypass valve;
  - (2) Removing a water meter from the meter setting:
  - (3) <u>Installing an unapproved bypass around the meter, or drawing water before the meter;</u>
    - (4) Damaging the water meter or related components;
    - (5) Reversing the water meter;
    - (6) Removing the meter register;

- (7) Causing the meter register to not register or to under register;
- (8) Cutting or disconnecting the wire between the meter and the endpoint;
  - (9) Removing or damaging the endpoint;
- (10) Opening the curb stop or other meter bypass valve or other Division of Water control valve that the Division of Water has shut off, without the Division of Water's prior authorization;
- (11) <u>Using water from a hydrant or other unmetered part of water</u> system without the Division of Water's prior authorization, except that municipal firefighting and service department use are allowed uses not requiring preauthorization;
- (12) <u>Using water from a private fireline for other than firefighting and testing purposes; or</u>
- (13) Improperly tapping or tying into an existing water main or service connection.
- (b) Any person <u>found by the Division of Water to have violated division (a) of this section shall be subject to any or all of the following:</u>
  - (1) The Tampering Fees as specified in Section 535.06,
  - (2) The labor and material costs to repair any damaged equipment,
  - (3) The payment of the cost of twice the estimated amount of water which has not been registered because of tampering with a System, billed at the applicable additional MCF rate, and
  - (4) Shutting or re-shutting off of water service in accordance with the Division of Water's Rules and Regulations.

- (b) For Master Meter Communities. All bills for water furnished shall be rendered monthly to the municipality or district to which water is so furnished, and if not paid within fifteen (15) days after the date of billing by the City of Cleveland, such bills shall be subject to a penalty of five percent (5%) added thereto each month to all past due balances. In the event that any monthly bill is not paid within four (4) months after written notice is given by the City of Cleveland, the City of Cleveland may, at its option, cease to furnish water to such municipality or district pending payment of any overdue amount.
- (c) Rates for Standby Emergency Water Service. The rates to be charged for standby emergency water service shall consist of an annual standby fee of three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600.00) per year a monthly fee of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) in addition to the charge for consumption provided in division (a) of this section. Standby fees for standby emergency water service shall be payable in advance. All bills for water furnished under this section shall be rendered upon the termination of customer's emergency period or, if the duration of the emergency is longer than thirty (30) days, in thirty (30) day intervals. Any outstanding balance not paid within fifteen (15) days after the date of billing by the City of Cleveland, such bills shall be subject to a penalty of five percent (5%) each month to all past due balances. In the event that any standby fee is not paid in advance or any consumption bill is not paid within four (4) months after written notice is given by the City of Cleveland, the City of Cleveland may at its option, cease to furnish standby emergency water service to such customer pending payment of any overdue amount.
- (d) Large Industrial Customers. All water used in excess of twenty million, eight hundred thirty three thousand (20,833,000) cubic feet during a one (1) month billing period shall be charged at a rate of seventy-five percent (75%) of the rate prescribed in this section for water used in excess of one thousand (1,000) cubic feet at the additional mcf rate.
- (c) Customers Supplied from More than One (1) Service District. Customers with premises supplied with water from more than one (1) service district shall be billed at the rate for the service district from which the predominant quantity of water is supplied.

- (f) (e) Water rates shall be charged based on the location of the water meter when determining whether a water account is located within City of Cleveland or a suburban community, or whether it is located within Cuyahoga County.
- (g) (f) All rates shall be effective on January 1 of each year, except as otherwise provided herein for 2021. The final year rates listed shall remain in effect until new rates are approved.

#### Section 535.05 Affordability Programs

(a) Special Homestead Rate. Homestead rates are eligible for single family residential property owned and occupied by a person sixty-five (65) years of age or older whose total annual income does not exceed the annual income limits set by the Director of Public Utilities starting with the 2021 year with an annual income of \$34,500. Income limits shall increase annually based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) annual inflation, but shall not exceed 3% annually. Eligible properties approved shall be charged listed below may be eligible for the special homestead rate established for the service district in which the homestead is located under Section 535.04 of these Codified Ordinances. The Director of Public Utilities shall prescribe the application form for the homestead rates and have final approval of all applications.

(b) The Director of Public Utilities may establish an affordability program to provide assistance to eligible low-income customers. The program may offer a reduction of forty percent (40%) from the water bill for residential customers with an annual income that does not exceed 200% of the Federal Poverty Income Guideline
