Purpose:

This Department requests legislation to grant consent to the ODOT to construct the improvement for Towpath Trail Phase 4 Trailhead with three (3) additive alternates for Stone Curbing, Perennial Plantings and Grass Plantings; to cause payment to ODOT for local share in the estimated amount of \$206,400 from any and all funds as authorized by Director of Finance; to authorize the Director of Capital Projects or Public Works to enter into one or more agreements as are necessary to make the improvement.

Description:

The City has arranged for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports. ODOT will arrange the project sale, award to the lowest responsible bidder and provide construction supervision and administration of the improvement. The Trailhead project was selected by NOACA as part of the Towpath implementation. Improvement includes creating a larger trailhead by removing excess parking and installing a greenspace buffer between trail users and vehicular parking at the terminus of the Towpath Trail Phase 4 (Tremont/Literary Trailhead to Canal Basin Park) in the City of Cleveland. Includes benches and interpretive elements with three (3) additive alternates for Stone Curbing, Perennial Plantings and Grass Plantings.
