#### East 66th Street Roadway Improvement

Ordinance No.

Purpose:

Amend Ordinance 822-2020 passed December 9, 2020; Section 2 for direct award contract to The Osborn Engineering Company for compensation to be paid for the preliminary engineering service for a cost not to exceed \$250,000 to \$431,332; Section 10; add fund numbers for any and all funds as authorized by Director of Finance (20-568, 20-574, 20-579, 20-586, 20-592, 20-597).

**Description:** 

Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative Schematic Design for East 66th Street from Euclid Avenue to Superior Avenue was submitted to NOACA on June 30, 2020. Council approved a direct award contract to Osborn Engineering Company to develop the scope of work to a preferred alternative. The scope of work will included preliminary plans options, land acquisition assessment, underground utilities preliminary alignment, drainage requirements, environment screening, geotechnical evaluation, green infrastructure evaluation. The preliminary design options, operation and maintenance costs and projected construction costs will be presented to the City for review, input and approval to arrive at the preferred alternate. The construction costs will be calculated for the following limits:

- Euclid to Linwood 2,900 feet
- Euclid to Wade Park 4,3300 feet
- Euclid to Superior 5,400 feet

The cost estimates developed in this process will determine the structure of future cooperation and management strategy and the City's financial and programming support for the project.



#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Sections 2 and 10 of Ordinance No. 822-2020, passed December 9, 2020, relating to the East 66<sup>th</sup> Street Roadway Improvement Project.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Sections 2 and 10 of Ordinance No. 822-2020, passed

December 9, 2020, are amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the Director of Capital Projects is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Osborn Engineering for professional services necessary to design the Improvement from Euclid Avenue to Superior Avenue, or to other East 66th Street intersections within the aforementioned limits, for the Office of Capital Projects. The compensation to be paid for the preliminary design services shall not exceed \$250,000 \$431,332\$ unless additional grant funds or other funds as authorized by the Director of Finance are made available, and the compensation to be paid for other professional design services shall be fixed by the Board of Control.

Section 10. That the cost of the contracts, property acquisition, or other expenditure shall be paid from Fund Nos. 20 SF 568, 20 SF 574, 20 SF 579, 20 SF 586, 20 SF 592, 20 SF 597, from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant funds or gifts accepted under this ordinance, and any other funds approved by the Director of Finance. (RQS 0103, RLA 2020-61 and RQS 0103, RLA 2021-16)

Section 2. That existing Sections 2 and 10 of Ordinance No. 822-2020, passed December 9, 2020, are repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
