

Ordinance No. 309-2021

By Council Members McCormack, Bishop, Brancatelli and Kelley (by departmental request)

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into a license agreement with the Board of Trustees of the Cleveland Public Library, to use and occupy City-owned property, for the installation of prebuilt StoryWalk station stands, and for ongoing use and maintenance of StoryWalk station stands at Frank Novak Park, adjacent to the Carnegie West Branch Library, for an initial term of three years and automatically renewing year to year unless terminated by either party.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; and,

WHEREAS, StoryWalk is a national program to encourage children to enjoy reading and the outdoors at the same time by installing laminated pages from a children's picture book along an outdoor path; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That, notwithstanding Section 183.16 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into a license agreement with the Board of Trustees of the Cleveland Public Library (the "Library") whereby the City is granting the Library the right to use and occupy City-owned property, for the installation of prebuilt StoryWalk station stands, and for ongoing use and maintenance of StoryWalk station stands at Frank Novak Park, adjacent to the Carnegie West Branch Library, at a cost of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration.

Section 2. That the term of the license agreement shall be for an initial term of three years and automatically renewing year to year unless terminated by either party upon written notice.

Section 3. That the license agreement shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 4. That the Director of Public Works and the Director of Law, and other appropriate City officials, are authorized to execute such other documents and certificates, and take such other action as may be necessary or appropriate to effect the license agreement or agreements authorized by this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
