Request for Legislation

Ordinance No. 370-2020, passed by City Council on June 17, 2020, authorized the Department of Public Utilities to enter into a direct award contract or contracts with Itron Incorporated, its automated meter reading (AMR) system provider, for the continuation of hardware maintenance, software maintenance and the addition of professional services related to upgrades of existing software systems. The ordinance also allows for the purchase of software licensing and replacement meter reading hardware. The Department wishes to amend this Ordinance to request additional funding to complete the above mentioned summary of scope of work/commodities/services, but still targeted for the same programmatic scope.

Background/Purpose:

Itron is the provider of Cleveland Water's AMR system. This request includes a continuation of the current hardware and software support. Renewal is necessary to maintain the software and hardware to ensure reliable operation. The related professional services are to upgrade proprietary software systems to also further ensure the reliability of the network and increase its ability to collect accurate data. Additional meter reading hardware and software licensing is required to replace outdated or end of life equipment and out of support software.

Scope of Work/Commodities/Services:

This renewal covers support, maintenance, hardware, software, and professional services outlined in the table below.

Professional services are required to upgrade FDM and Mobile Collector Software which are both currently out of support. Professional services are also required in the contract to replace MVRS which must be replaced by December 2021.

Funds will be covered from the general operating funds from CWD. Appropriations will be made annually from free balance for future years.

The direct award contract or contracts for the term of two years, with a one-year option to renew.
