# **Ordinance No. 403-2020**

### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Designating East 124<sup>th</sup> Street between Superior Avenue and Auburndale Avenue with a secondary and honorary designation of "Jane B. Sheats Way".

WHEREAS, the citizens of Cleveland want to honor Jane B. Sheats with a secondary street sign designation of "Jane B. Sheats Way" in recognition of her service as a change maker who sticks with a problem until it is solved since 1955 when she and her husband Marvin purchased their home on East 124th Street in the Glenville area; and

WHEREAS, as president of the street club, Jane B. Sheats first accomplished getting a bus shelter at the end of the street, and next, after working for a year, she got a traffic light installed on Lakeview Avenue for the safety of children crossing to attend neighborhood schools; and

WHEREAS, as chairperson of the Cuyahoga County Board of Election, when she questioned why "register to vote here" signs were only posted in the suburbs, it was corrected after a 1976 Cleveland Press article; and as regional manager of the Ohio Lottery Cleveland office she changed how new instant tickets were given to the stories when they came out for the whole state; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Sheats was honored in the congressional record for being the first African-American in the country to chair a board of election from 1976-1979; and as a member of the Patient Advisory Committee, her five year effort and petition to increase presence of Congresswoman Stephanie Tubbs Jones helped a building be named after her; and

WHEREAS, Jane B. Sheats is the proud mother of three children, seven grandchildren, and ten great-grandchildren with two more coming this year; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety; now, therefore,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That East 124<sup>th</sup> Street between Superior Avenue and Auburndale Avenue is designated with a secondary and honorary designation of "Jane B. Sheats Way".

<u>Section 2</u>. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
