AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 952-2020, passed December 9, 2020, relating to authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into a grant agreement with the Near West Side Multi-Service Center dba May Dugan Center, to make repairs to the City-owned facility located at 4115 Bridge Avenue.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 952-2020, passed December 9, 2020, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the cost of the grant shall not exceed an amount of \$425,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. ~~14 SF 040~~ 14 SF 046 (RQS 8006, RL 2020-117) and prior year balances.

Section 2. That existing Section 3 of Ordinance No. 952-2020, passed December 9, 2020, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
