NO COST GROUND LEASE WITH CMSD FOR CITY'S JOHN F. KENNEDY RECREATION CENTER

Legislative Purpose:

To authorize the Director of the Department of Public Works to enter into a no cost ground lease with Cleveland Metropolitan School District ("CMSD") for City's John F. Kennedy Recreation Center located at 17300 Harvard Avenue on CMSD's old John F. Kennedy High School campus.

Project Summary:

In the late 1960s, the City of Cleveland and CMSD formed a Joint Recreation Council to explore the feasibility of co-locating schools and recreation centers for the mutual benefit of the community. In the late 1960s and early 1970s, three City recreation centers were constructed on CMSD property without the benefit of a lease to the City. These schools were Glenville Recreation Center at Glenville High School, Stella Walsh Recreation Center at South High School, and John F. Kennedy Recreation Center at John F. Kennedy High School.

Current bond requirements dictate that bond proceeds can only be spent on property owned by the City, or which the City is occupying under a long-term lease or easement. As such, in 2019 the City Council passed Ordinance No. 889-2019, authorizing the City to enter into ground leases with CMSD for Glenville and Stella Walsh Recreation Centers to allow for operation and maintenance of those facilities. Legislation is still needed to enter into a ground lease with CMSD for the John F. Kennedy Recreation Center.

The JFK Recreation Center was constructed by the City under the bleachers of the JFK High School Kidd Football Field, which is located behind the old JFK High School.

The JFK Recreation Center will be decommissioned when the new Ward 1 Recreation Center is completed. This ground lease is needed to expend bond funds on maintenance, operation, and eventually demolition of the recreation center.


