

Ordinance No. 541-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. LS 2019-019 with Cleveland Coordinating Committee for the Cod, Inc. to operate a submarine museum and memorial.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 251-2019, passed March 25, 2019, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. LS 2019-019 with Cleveland Coordinating Committee for the Cod, Inc. (the “USS Cod”) to operate a submarine museum and memorial; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 251-2019 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, for the use of the Leased premises, the USS Cod shall pay the City an annual fee as specified in the contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. LS 2019-019 with the USS Cod to operate a submarine museum and memorial. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 251-2019 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
